BREAD Behold the Lamb (vv. 1-2)

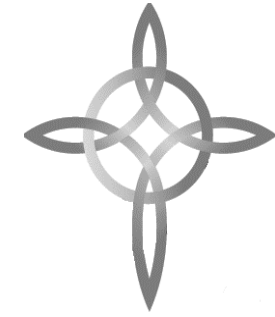
