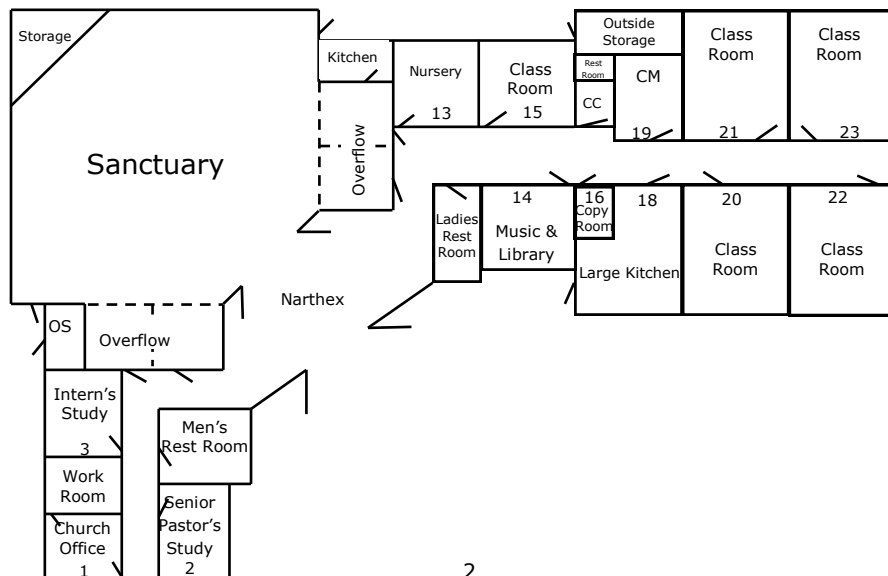
Worship—10:30 a.m.

The purpose is not to discourage children from playing there but to ensure proper supervision for the safety of all of our children and to appropriately limit the liability of our church.
