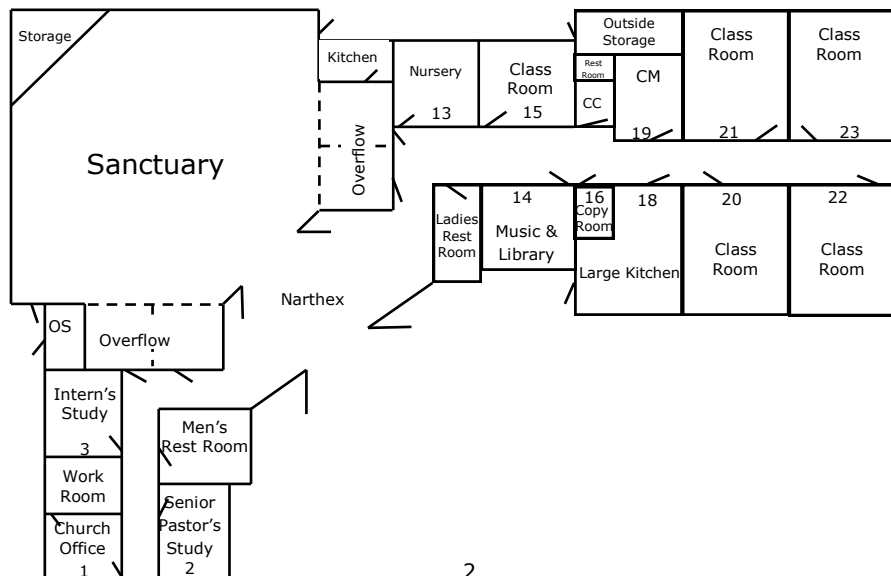
Worship—10:30 a.m.

Exciting Response in Pledges to Missions Fund

We have great news to share with you! Through the Lord's wonderful provision, and the generosity of this Congregation, pledges to our Missions Fund submitted at the end of our recent Missions Conference jumped over \$10,000 compared to the pledges made a year ago. This is truly a blessing! Pledges to our Missions Program, which had been funded by the General Fund until 2009, have increased over the past 4 years from \$15,732 in 2009 to \$39,905! On a side
