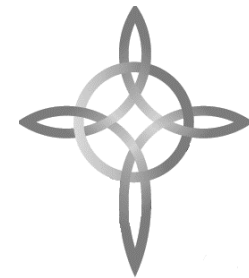
PARKING LOT CHANGES
