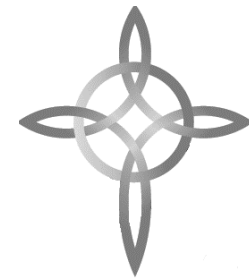
† MEET AND GREET CAFÉ
