From the Pastor's Desk

Starting the 2023 – 2024 Ministry Year

Our 2023 – 2024 ministry year begins on Sunday, September 3, 2023.

Most of our ministries take off from Memorial Day to Labor Day. That is, ministries conclude Memorial Day weekend and then resume on Labor Day weekend. The purpose of this break is to give ministry team members and their leaders a chance to rest. So, hopefully, everyone is rested and refreshed and ready to resume our 2023 – 2024 ministry year!

New Tampa Christian Academy (NTCA) started classes on Monday, August 14, 2023. NTCA is offering classes every weekday for 2-, 3-, and 4-year-old students. Ashleigh Kemp is our NTCA Director and she has done an excellent job of preparing for the new preschool year. We are encouraged to report once again that we have full enrollment, with a number of prospective students on the waiting list.

On Sunday, September 3, we plan to resume our Sunday school classes for all ages. There will be classes for students of all ages. And there will also be classes for adults. This fall, there will be two Adult Bible Fellowship classes. All of these classes will begin at 9:15 a.m. on Sunday mornings.

Morning Worship Services will continue on Sundays at 10:45 a.m.

Evening Worship Services, which had been on hold during the summer, will continue to be on pause in the fall. The Session wants to encourage the establishment of a robust Youth Ministry that currently meets twice-monthly on Sunday evenings.

The Men's Bible Study will begin meeting on Saturday morning, September 2, 2023 at 8:00 a.m. in the Youth Room. Ably led by Rod Proctor, the men are continuing their study in Paul's letter to the Romans. After spending time in God's word, all men are invited to continue their fellowship over breakfast at a local restaurant.

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The Women's Bible Studies begin on Tuesday, September 5, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. They will be studying Remember Your Joy: A Bible Study of Salvation Stories in the Old Testament. A second offering is The Word of the Lord: Seeing Jesus in the Prophets, and these groups will meet either Monday evenings at 6:30 p.m. (on Zoom, starting Monday, September 11) or Tuesday mornings at 10:00 a.m. (in the Youth Room, starting on Tuesday, September 12). The leaders for the various WBS groups are Melissa Bayley, Eileen Fritz, and Debbie Jordan.

The Youth Ministry meets on Sundays. They will have Sunday school classes at 9:15 a.m. on Sunday mornings in the Youth Room. In addition, they will meet twice a month on Sunday evenings at 5:00 p.m. Check the calendar for meeting dates.

An all-church retreat is planned for Friday through Sunday, November 10 - 12, 2023. This will once again be held at the Lakeside Retreat in Brooksville. This will be the fourth year we will have had this retreat. It is a wonderful opportunity for fellowship and fun.

English as a Second Language (ESL) classes start the day after Labor Day on September 5, 2023. This ministry has really grown over the past few years under the leadership of Karen Cross.

As we begin this new ministry year, let me encourage you to get involved in a ministry at the church. The Bible teaches that every Christian is part of the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:27). There are many opportunities to serve in our church family. All ministries are looking for team members. Contact a ministry team member to volunteer your time and talent!

Pray that the Lord will glorify himself in our service to him this coming year. Pray that the church of Jesus Christ will be strengthened and grow in health. And pray that those outside the church family may come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ, so that we may all grow to maturity in Christ.

Our last outing was April 29, at the Babe Zaharias Golf Course in Tampa. Summer has made it a little difficult to coordinate a date for the next outing. Gie Walker invited us to play at The Heritage Isles Golf Club, 10630 Plantation Bay Drive, Tampa, 33647.

We were finally able to fix a date. Our third outing will take place on Saturday, September 30. The cost is \$45, which includes a cart. We will not know the tee-time until September 22. When Gie made our arrangements to play, she was given a 9 a.m. tee-time. However, there is a shotgun start at 8:30 a.m. of 100 players on September 30. It is not clear how this oversight occurred, but Gie and I thought it best to keep the date.

Our tee-time will be as early as 10:30 a.m. or possibly as late as 1 p.m. I expect it will be around 10:30 a.m. We trust this will not be a problem. We hope the weather will be milder and the later-than-planned start will not be of concern.

Golfers of all levels are welcome. We play a Scramble Style which enables everyone at whatever of level to enjoy playing together. For those unfamiliar with Scramble, it means the players in a four-some compete as a team against the other teams. Each player hits his or her ball during the round, but may not hit subsequent shots from where the ball came to rest. Rather, the ball deemed the better shot by the team will be the place where each player hits next. There is one score per hole for the team and thus one team score. In addition, we will consider other ideas to increase the fun.

Lord willing, afterwards, we'll meet in the clubhouse to round out the day. Our hope is to play different courses in the greater Tampa area at a reasonable cost. HelloOo, Parents!

Do you know all the words to *Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star*?....How about *Happy Birthday*?...And *Jesus Loves Me*?

Sure, you know them! Do you know why? You learned them as a child when your mind was fresh and eager to learn new things, and you learned them to music!

For several years on our Sunday School, we have used *Ask Me WhoOo*. It's the music of a three-volume CD set with Scripture and the Children's First Catechism, both word-for-word. It is so easy to memorize as a singalong! *Ask Me WhoOo* has been included in Sunday School for Toddlers through 5th Graders underscoring our *Show Me Jesus!* curriculum. Yes, Toddlers! Don't under-estimate those little sponge brains!

Now, there's an exciting NEW part! Kids who are signed up for Sunday School this year who memorize and recite or sing will about 13 Q&As and verses each quarter will earn Bucks up to...

\$25 Media Bucks or 2-3 year-olds for Bibles. Christian books, music, or videos.

\$50 Media Bucks for 4 year- olds through 2nd Graders.

\$100 in Camp Bucks or Media Bucks towards Christian camp 3^{rd} through 5^{th} Graders.

Perhaps the most important part of all of this is that we will be grounding our Covenant children in the basic tenants of our faith. I know it's no surprise to you that young people today are bombarded with lies that lead them astray. Even children who have grown up in church, too often leave later. They don't know what they believe. If they don't know what they believe in, they will believe in anything. The culture these kids are growing up in is broken and evil. Satan wants to destroy our kids! Record numbers of our kids are depressed and committing suicide because they have no solid biblical foundation.

A 2022 study¹ focused on the Gen X, born 1960 - 1980 produced some shocking statistics:

70% listed themselves as Christian on surveys, but -

44% never read the Bible.

63% said Right from Wrong was "situational."

31% never go to church.

57% never participate in a Bible study.

33% do not believe that the Bible is the Word of God.

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According to this same study, "If someone has robust religious experiences growing up, they are likely to maintain their beliefs and practices into adulthood."

At the baptism of our Covenant babies, we all raise our hands and pledge that we will help the parents to raise the child up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. But unless we are Sunday School or Children's Church teachers or Nursery workers, we don't have much interaction with the young ones. However, one of the most rewarding experiences I've had in this church was taking part in the *Pray for Me* campaign. I had two sweet boys to pray for. In my interaction with them, I asked each of them how I could pray for them. It was so rewarding! I really got to know them when otherwise I would not have.

So how can you help in keeping our young ones in church, and in the Word? Our TBPC Family has 21 Toddlers through 5th Graders who are children of TBPC members. We pray each one will be enrolled and in regular Sunday School attendance this year! That means we would need 21 volunteers to be "Coaches," (or "Buddies"), to listen to the children recite the memorized Scripture and Catechism. For you to volunteer would mean no study or prep time, very little extra time at the church, and no special skills. Just love, interest, and prayer! This is a such great way to get to know a one of our TBPC kids and for one of them one of them to get to know you. This only involves a few minutes after church, plus listening and evaluating a recitation once a quarter. We also plan to have an all-church *Ask Me WhoOo* Sing-Along at the in May.

Our kids will memorize quickly as they sing *Ask Me WhoOo* each week in Sunday School, at home, in a park, or in the car with parents and sibs or even by themselves. The *Ask Me WhoOo* Song Time during the Second Sunday Evening Service each month will make memorizing easier still! Right now, we also need four more for our Sunday School Team, Teachers and Assistants! since we only have half of the teachers we need. Most of all, we need parents to be committed to bringing their kids each week to Sunday School and to be listeners and encouragers for their kid as they practice reciting or singing what they have learned.

Let's to bridge the age gap at TBPC! We need everyone to pray as we kick this program off in the In September. Ask God what He wants you to do to help to rescue our children. He has a job for each of us!






