From the Pastor's Desk

Remember, Ponder, and Meditate

The psalmist writes the following in Psalm 77:11-12: "I will remember the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will remember your wonders of old. I will ponder all your work, and meditate on your mighty deeds."

The psalmist has consciously decided to *remember* the deeds of the Lord and his words of old, *ponder* all God's work, and *meditate* on God's mighty deeds.

But where would the psalmist learn of all these things about God?

The only place available to the psalmist was the word of God.

The word of God is the repository of the deeds of the Lord, his works of old, his word, and his mighty deeds. It is only in the word of God that these things are found.

As you and I prepare for 2024, I want to encourage you to do what the psalmist did. I want to encourage you to read the word of God. I want to encourage you to remember, ponder, and meditate on the word of God. For it is in your reading of the word of God that you will grow strong in the faith.

If you will join the psalmist in this purposeful way of living, rather than just drifting and coasting into the new year, then mark off time today to plan by asking yourself three questions:

First, when will I fit the reading of God's word into my day? What can I change to make it fit?

Second, *where* at home or work will I read and begin my meditations and prayers? Where can I make some quiet and solitude? If you want it, you can make it.

And third, *how* will I read my Bible this year? Will I read a chapter a day? Will I use the Daily Bible Reading guide? Will I use a thematic guide? Will I use a devotional help?

As you commit yourself to the word of God, I believe you will discover that you will have a truly wonderful 2024.




